

Copy of objection sent on 23rd November 2011 by Lydford Parish Council to
Dartmoor National Park Authority.

The Parish Council object to the planning application ref 0552/11 for the following reasons:

- Land is not part of & never has been part of a designated development area. It is agricultural.
- Proposed building is too close in proximity to the school & overlooks the school building & proposed playing field.
- No local need established.
- Any development on this land will be incredibly disruptive to the school & be potentially very hazardous.
- Local feeling overwhelmingly against the development proposition & the implicit threat posed to the school & therefore the entire local community.
- Applications (x 3?) to build on this land have what we consider to be rightfully declined previously.
